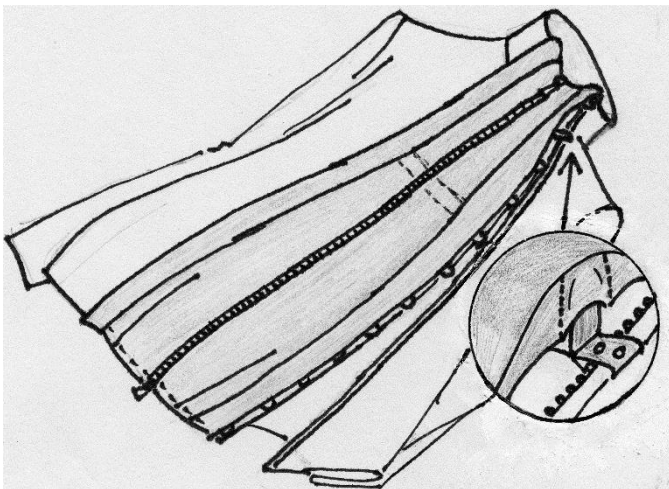




Instructions for maternity mode

1. Remove your extender from packaging and keep it in the zipped position. (Note: If your extender is wrinkled, spray with water and place in the dryer on medium heat for 10 minutes. Using a mesh lingerie bag will extend the life of this product and protect the clips.)
2. Open all clips on both sides of the extender. Beginning at the top, place the first clip of the extender over the zipper teeth of your coat, and clamp down on the zipper tape. Work your way down one side and repeat the process on the other side.
3. Make sure the tops of the clips are inserted properly in the designated clip pocket to ensure that the storm flaps stay tightly closed (See figure A)
4. Once the extender is secured to your jacket, unzip from top to bottom. Your jacket is now ready to wear! Adjust the width at the chest and at the bottom by pulling the draw cords and toggles which are located inside. This allows a more fitted look, and keeps the cold air out.

Instructions for baby wearing mode

The extendher is NOT intended as child carrier. Please follow your instructions carefully when using your front baby carrier or sling. Carrier not provided.

1. Put on your baby carrier and place your baby in the secured position. While wearing your jacket, use a piece of tape to mark where the carrier meets your coat's zipper. If you use a sling or a wrap, place the tape in line with where the baby's neck meets their head.
2. Remove your coat and place it on a flat surface. With the wide part of the extendher at the top, begin clipping the extendher where you have the tape marked. Continue down to the hem, then remove the tape. Repeat the same distance and procedure on the other side. If the extendher is longer than the coat, you can easily fold the excess up and clip it to the inside of your coat. You can also let it hang down for extra coverage.
3. Unzip the extendher and put your coat on, encasing the baby in the carrier. To zip your coat closed, start at the top and zip down to the bottom. To remove, simply unzip from the bottom to top. It's best to practice and make any appropriate adjustments. Use caution with toggles and zippers near baby's face and mouth.

EASY HOOD ATTACHMENT INSTRUCTIONS (sold separately)

1. Press the Velcro tabs on the hood to the Velcro on the extendher fleece inside storm flaps
2. Place the loop that is located on the extendher logo label around the button which is located under the top layer of the hood.
3. Secure the fleece layer and move it to the inside of the extendher (encasing it) to keep out cold air.

The Easy Hood Attachment is not intended as a hat. Always dress your baby accordingly.

CLIP REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS (See figure B)

You will need needle nose pliers.

A) The ring will still be attached to the extendher. Place the bottom part, gel grips up, under the ring with the ring extending out of the side slots.

B) The middle part goes through the center square hole and place the extensions through the side slots. You will feel some spring action when you apply pressure as you push down.

C) While continuing to press down, firmly hold all the pieces in place and put the top piece on as shown. Push the extensions through the holes and snap in place. Straighten the outside walls of the clip with pliers to keep from slipping out.

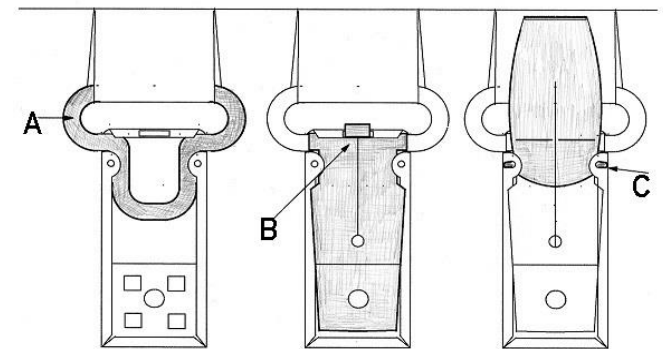
